- 1. PSD events are held on October 16 and 17, 2023.
- 2. Political Science (POSC)/ International Studies (INST) classes (except mock trial/moot court) are cancelled those two days. Other classes proceed as normal.
- 3. POSC students must attend one PSD session for each POSC/INST class session missed during the PSD time frame.
- 4. Students should submit tickets they receive at their PSD events (with their names and sessions written on them) to their regular professors at the first post-Poli Sci Days class session. Some professors may have additional PSD-related assignments to demonstrate attendance.
- 5. Students may attend any Poli Sci Days events they wish (they do not need to attend a session at their normal class time), but events are first come first served. So, don't wait until last minute.
